Dear Mr. Richardson:

This letter, when countersigned, authorizes funding by the Placer County Transportation Planning Agency (PCTPA) for work to be performed by the City of Auburn for the Western Placer Consolidated Transportation Services Community Transit Enhancement Project.

- Funding Agreement: This Funding Agreement is the statement of contract specific requirements applicable to the work effort to be undertaken by the City of Auburn for the Western Placer Consolidated Transportation Services Community Transit Enhancement Project. The Western Placer Consolidated Transportation Services Community Transit Enhancement Project will be funded under the Public Transit Modernization Improvement Service Enhancement Account (PTMISEA) included in Proposition 1B, the Highway Safety, Traffic Reduction, Air Quality and Port Security Bond Act, approved by California voters in November 2006. The Western Placer Consolidated Transportation Services Community Transit Enhancement Project Public Transit Modernization Improvement Service Enhancement Account Corrective Action Plan for FY 2008/09 and FY 2009/10 is incorporated in this Funding Agreement.
- **Term:** City is to commence work immediately and shall be completed no later than December 31, 2012, according to the project schedule / milestones provided in the Public Transit Modernization Improvement Service Enhancement Account Corrective Action Plan for FY 2008/09 and FY 2009/10.
- 3. <u>Scope of Services</u>: City will perform the tasks / milestones to manage and install the Western Placer Consolidated Transportation Services Community Transit Enhancement Project provided in the Public Transit Modernization Improvement Service Enhancement Account Corrective Action Plan for FY 2008/09 and FY 2009/10.

- **Personnel:** City will provide its own personnel to perform the work specified in the Funding Agreement. City will also provide administrative support, management, and overhead expenses.
- **Compensation:** For services rendered, the City of Auburn will receive a sum not to exceed the amount of \$57,140 (plus accrued interest) identified in the Western Placer Consolidated Transportation Services Community Transit Enhancement Project Public Transit Modernization Improvement Service Enhancement Account Corrective Action Plan for FY 2008/09 and FY 2009/10. Upon completion of the project, the City of Auburn shall submit one invoice for reimbursement. The invoice for payment shall reference the work completed and the hours and cost associated with each task / milestone.
