

18 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to California Government Code, Title 7.91, Section 67910, PCTPA
19 was created as a local area planning agency to provide regional transportation planning for
20 the area of Placer County, exclusive of the Lake Tahoe Basin; and

21 **WHEREAS**, California Government Code Section 29532.1(c) identifies PCTPA as the
22 designated regional transportation planning agency for Placer County, exclusive of the Lake
23 Tahoe Basin; and

24 **WHEREAS**, it is the responsibility of PCTPA to review Bicycle and Pedestrian Trust Fund
25 Claims and to take action on such claims; and

26 **WHEREAS**, all Bicycle and Pedestrian Trust Fund Claims for projects must be consistent
27 with the applicable bicycle plan and with the Regional Transportation Plan.
