WHEREAS, pursuant to California Government Code, Title 7.91, Section 67910, PCTPA was created as a local area planning agency to provide regional transportation planning for the area of Placer County, exclusive of the Lake Tahoe Basin; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 29532.1(c) identifies PCTPA as the designated regional transportation planning agency for Placer County, exclusive of the Lake Tahoe Basin; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of PCTPA to prepare jurisdiction allocations and submit applications, as needed, from the Proposition 1B – Public Transportation Modernization, Improvement and Service Enhancement Account (PTMISEA).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that PCTPA:

1. Approves the FY 2010/11 PTMISEA Final Fund Allocation; and
2. Determines that projects derived from transit operator Short Range Transit Plans, the Placer County Regional Transportation Plan 2035, and the Metropolitan Transportation Plan for 2035 are eligible projects for purposes for applying for PTMISEA funds; and
3. Designates the Executive Director as the authorized agent to execute for and on behalf of the Placer County Transportation Planning Agency (PCTPA), including jurisdictions within Placer County, and local Transit Operators, any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining PTMISEA funds provided by the California Department of Transportation.
