



Role of Airport Land Use Commission

- Adopt and maintain Airport Land Use Compatibility Plans.
- 2. Review changes to plans, zoning, regulations near airports.

State Law

- Jurisdictions with airports required to amend their General
 Plan within 180 days of adoption of the ALUCP; or
- Jurisdiction can adopt findings and override ALUC; or
- Jurisdiction can refer all projects within airport influence area until General Plan consistency is determined.
- Once consistent, ALUC's authority to review projects becomes limited and a local responsibility except for mandatory reviews.

Three Potential Determinations

- 1. Consistent with the ALUCP.
- 2. Consistent with the ALUCP subject to conditions.
- 3. Inconsistent with the ALUCP based on specific conflicts.



General Plan Consistency

- Four ways for General Plan to be consistent:
 - 1. Incorporate policies into General Plan Elements.
 - 2. Adopt a General Plan Airport Element.
 - 3. Adopt the ALUCP as a stand-alone document.
 - 4. Adopt an Airport Combining District or Overlay Zoning Ordinance.
- Lincoln's approach is to incorporate airport land use compatibility policies into General Plan.

General Plan Consistency Cont'd.

- Per Caltrans Airport Land Use Handbook, General Plan does not have to be identical to be consistent.
- Two tests to determine consistency with ALUCP:
 - No direct conflicts can exist between ALUCP and General Plan.
 - Delineation of a mechanism or process for ensuring future land use development will not conflict with ALUCP.

Test 1: No direct conflicts can exist...

- General Plan policies addressing airport land use compatibility eliminate direct conflicts and support policies/criteria of ALUCP.
- City will need to amend or supplement General Plan to reflect the new ALUCP map for Lincoln Regional Airport.
- Two conditions to bring General Plan into consistency:
 - Reflect new Wildlife Hazard Critical Zone on General Plan maps.
 - 2. Reflect updated Compatibility Zone A (south) on General Plan maps.



Reflect New Wildlife Hazard Critical Zone on General Plan Map





Test 2: Delineation of a mechanism...

- Consistency between General Plan and ALUCP is established by Land Use Element.
- General Plan adoption by City Council establishes policy that all development must be consistent with ALUCP.
- Government Code requires Zoning Ordinance consistency with General Plan. Zoning Ordinance provides mechanism to assure compliance and implement ALUCP.
- All development is subject to some form of planning review.
 City review procedures are adequate to assure ALUCP criteria will be tied to development and be enforced.

Staff Recommendation

- Recommend Lincoln General Plan 2050, subject to two conditions outlined below, is consistent because:
 - 1. There would be no direct conflicts with ALUCP; and
 - 2. A mechanism is in place for ensuring future development within airport influence area will not conflict with ALUCP.
- Two required conditions:
 - Reflect new Wildlife Hazard Critical Zone on General Plan maps.
 - 2. Reflect the updated Compatibility Zone A (south) on the General Plan maps.
